Lord's Prayer Labyrinth Scriptures to Support Contemplation and Reflection

Petal 1 – Faith

- Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. *Heb. 11:1*
- So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen, since what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. *2 Corinthians 4:18*
- And he said: “Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. *Matthew 18:3*
- For, “Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?” But we have the mind of Christ. *1 Corinthians 2:16*
- I no longer call you servants because a servant does not know his master’s business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. *John 15:15*
- But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. *Galatians 5:22-23*

Petal 2 – Surrender

- Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. *John 14:6*

Petal 3 – Service

- You see that his faith and his actions were working together, and his faith was made complete by what he did...You see that a person is considered righteous by what they do and not by faith alone...As the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without deeds is dead. *James 2:22-26*
- If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth. *1 John 3:17-18*

Petal 4 – Nourishment

- The Lord’s Prayer. *Matthew 6:9-13*
- When the dew settled on the camp at night, the manna also came down. *Numbers 11:9*
- The people of Israel called the bread manna. ^[a] It was white like coriander seed and tasted like wafers made with honey. *Exodus 16:31*
- They asked, and he brought them quail; he fed them well with the bread of heaven. *Psalms 105:40*
- Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? *Matthew 6: 26*
- Then Jesus declared, “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty. *John 6:35*

Petal 5 – Forgiveness

- Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. *Luke 6:37*

Petal 6 – Overcoming/Strength

- The temptation of Jesus. *Luke 4:1-13*
- Peter’s denial of Jesus. *Luke 22:54-71*
- Jesus and Peter reunited – *John 21:15-19*
- I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. *John 10:11*

Doxology (Inner Circle of Love) - Robin

- And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love. *1 Corinthians 13:13*
- Whatever you ask for in prayer with faith, you will receive. *Matthew 21:22*
