The Island of Kaua'i is here for you to explore and enjoy for three months as you serve at the Christ Memorial Episcopal Church in Kīlauea. We are a small but active congregation with a thriving *Helen Mitsui Thrift Shop* across the street open six days a week and rented out Parish Hall for community organizations. The priest office is also across the street so that the new furnished vicarage can offer you maximum privacy. The new 2B/2.5B vicarage, dedicated as the *Queen Lili'uokalani Hale* sleeps 4 with garage/carport that has a half bath for use during Sunday morning services. We anticipate building will be completed by October 2023.

Time slots are now open starting Aug-Sept 2023 at a nearby 1B/1B unit in Kalihiwai Ridge and then October 2023 for 3 month increments thereafter to end of 2024 at the new vicarage.
