



## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: *What is Kapuakukui?***

A: Kapuakukui is Camp Mokule'ia's annual celebration event. We chose to start this tradition during the Camp's 75<sup>th</sup> year in operation! The festivities will be held on Saturday, September 3, 2022 beginning at 4:30 p.m. at the Camp. Guests can visit the silent auction and will be given a passport to tour the grounds. Entertainment will feature Kamuela Kahoano and 'Iolani School's Performing Arts, making it an evening to remember. A buffet dinner and beverages will be served. A highlight of the evening will be honoring The Rev. Canon David Kennedy for his decades of service and contributions to Camp Mokule'ia.

**Q: *Who benefits from the event proceeds?***

A: The proceeds from ticket sales, the silent auction, and donations will go toward the general maintenance and improvements at Camp Mokule'ia.

**Q: *Will you have a silent auction?***

A: Yes! Our goal is to raise \$10,000 in auction sales. The silent auction items will be on display on event night; however, bidding will be managed online only. Auction will open to the public prior to the event and close on event night. If you attend the event, you will be able to bid from the comfort of your seat. There will be volunteers available to help event guests with online bidding should the need arise. We welcome auction donations as well.

**Q: *How many people are expected at this event?***

A: We are expecting 300 guests and volunteers at Kapuakukui.

**Q: *What's the dress code for this event?***

A: Casual. Collared shirts/shorts for men, summer attire for women.

**Q: *Where do we park for this event?***

A: Drive up to the designated drop off area where you'll be greeted by a valet service.

**Q: *What is the price of a ticket?***

A: Individual tickets are \$125 per person if purchased by June 15 and \$150 per person thereafter. Tickets will be sold through August 1. Sponsored tables for 10 are available for purchase at three levels - \$5,000 (Kukui, which includes limousine transportation), \$2,500 (Ulu) and \$1,500 (Naupaka). Sponsorships are available through July 15.

**Q: *Are children allowed at this event?***

A: Children are definitely welcomed; however, the ticket price is not discounted for age. Please know that there will be alcohol served to our guests and that children should be supervised at all times.
